Ugborough Village Hall Has Got A New Roof!

Ugborough Village Hall recently received a new roof and Chair of the South Hams District Council, Councillor Tom Holway was there to complete the 'topping-out'. The Hall needed to replace the 1970s roof due to leaks causing water damage and the project has included replacement roof tiles, felting/membrane, battens, leadwork, dormer flat roof, fascias, soffits, rainwater goods and Velux windows. Rotted roof timbers were replaced and there was some upgrade to the existing roof insulation. The work was completed ahead of schedule by SMW Roofing Ltd and supported by local firms Tor Ecology and Croft Surveyors.

Although Tom could not get onto the new roof he was able to place the last piece on a lego version of the Hall at a ceremony to thank all those who helped raise the funds and supported the project.
